## Command Line Args

---

1. Modify your program from Worksheet 6 number 5 to take two arguments on the command line. It will read input from the file which is the first argument, modify the text (as in Worksheet 6, number 5) and output it to the file which is the second argument. If you didn't finish Worksheet 6, simply have it convert the text to all caps and output it to the file.

If your script is called `ws7_1.pl`, you can test it this way:

```
-> ./ws7_1.pl ~/stacia/ws05/data/song.txt song.out
```

2. Modify the previous program to substitute each occurrence of the words `mountain` or `mountains` with `cow` or `cows` respectively.
